In 1985, The Mayfair Hotel opened and instantly became an icon of Coconut Grove. With lavish ornamentation and an enigmatic fusion of cultural references and design styles, architect Kenneth Treister created a signature work of art that has transcended time. It is the rarest of designs, one so truly unique and distinctive that it looks timeless and magical to us today.

Densely layered and embellished, the maximalist, more-is-more design of the Mayfair stands in direct opposition to the sleek minimalism of the Art Deco movement. Treister's design is full of references to different global cultures, and easily allows for layering of new cultural influences such as Spanish architect Gaudi's Barcelona buildings. Its long history makes it a signature part of local history as well. Mayfair House Hotel & Garden sits in an enviable position: its distinctive design puts it in a category of one.

The hotel was conceived to break the mold of traditional American hotels, offering an all-suite oasis in which each guest suite is unique and conceived as a small private home with its own living, dining, and sleeping areas and a private terrace in each room.
